Building a snow person

If you have lots of snow you can build a wonderful snow person. Find some stones for the buttons. Can you give your snowman 10 or 20 buttons in different arrangements? Can you measure your snow person?

Snow writing

Can you use your finger or a stick to write your name in the snow? Can you practice writing the most recent phonics sounds and include these in a word?

Bird Feeders

Birds find it really hard to find food when it snows. Can you make a bird feeder by threading hooped cereals onto some string or a pipe cleaner? Hang it in your garden or outside a window for the birds to enjoy on this snowy day.
