<p>Writing</p> 	<p>In English, we have explored a range of text types over the half term. The unit below explores writing linked to influential women in history, specifically Harriet Tubman. Each lesson includes a video, slides, worksheets and quizzes: Harriet Tubman: Biographical writing</p> <p><u>Extention task</u> We have been learning grammar concepts using different sentence types; simple present, past or future tense and also incorporating modal verbs into sentences. <p>Maths</p> 	<p>In Maths, we have been learning about multiplication. Have a watch of the video and slides on How to multiply 3 digit by 2 digit number, then have a go at the questions and upload them to Google Classroom</p> <p>There is also an additional activity on multiplication on My Maths</p> <p><i>Don't forget to practise your times tables every day on TT Rockstars!</i></p>
<p>Topic</p> 	<p>In Geography, we have been learning about 'Where should we go on holiday?'. Have a look at the BBC bitesize lesson on The Alps and have a go at the activity at the bottom of the page. You could also create a mind map, poster or information page showing what you have learned that will help you later on in our topic</p> <p>In History, we have recently learnt about the Anglo Saxons. Follow the lessons and complete the work. At the end of each lesson test your knowledge against the quiz!</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>In Science, we are starting to look at life cycles. We are beginning by looking at the life cycle of a plant, take a look at the lesson on Life Cycles of a Flowering Plant.
